Bamboo has been our top raw material since 2010, used for the manufacturing of fabrics on account of its unique properties. Thanks to it, our mission 'We weave the future by improving your daily life' is based on values connected with ecology and concern for the safety of us all.

THE HIGHEST STANDARDS AND QUALITY CONFIRMED BY CERTIFICATES

OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100 certification indicates that all products of TEXPOL have been tested in terms of their safety for the skin and the environment. In practice, this means that both fabrics and ready products are tested, obligating us to work with certified partners. They include dyeworks, printing works, and even label manufacturers.

Quality is ensured by the quality department, which analyses in detail every inch of the fabric using modern rolling machines. This is confirmed by the ISO 9001 certificate.

ECOLOGY

TEXPOL takes care of the environment on many planes. From selecting bamboo as its main raw material, through ergonomic machines, to expensive certification that is the basic quarantee of care for the natural environment.

CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

We take pride in the fact that we are among the best fabric manufacturers in Europe, and we are proud we can work in Poland. It is also important to us that our fabrics are manufactured in collaboration with the local community, with at least half of our employees being to some extent disabled. This is how we understand the idea: **'You can only multiply by sharing'**.

ALGAE FABRICS

Out of concern for our common good, we created a collection of fabrics combining the bamboo fibre with algae.

Save the Ocean - this is our opinion on an important issue! We need to be heard, reminding everyone to take care of our planet - Mother Earth every day.

Only continuing care and sound decisions, also in terms of purchases, can protect the world of nature against severe and extremely dangerous climate change. This is why our fabrics are to remind users of our common responsibility for the safety and protection of our Planet.



The leitmotif of the *Save the Ocean* collection is a bird's-eye view of the water surface. Clear OCEAN waters allow to see through to the depths and to admire the fauna and flora bustling with life. To get to know new species of fish and jellyfish, and to admire corals and the picturesque beauty of marine algae. To us, this image of pure clean ocean is visual affirmation of the state we should be seeking as humanity. This is how we would like to encourage others to pay attention to the responsibility entailed by everyday purchase decisions. Our priorities are quality and environmentally friendly character of our fabrics.

Save the Ocean fabrics are a composition of bamboo fibres and SEACELL® fibres made of real marine algae. The plants we use as components for our collection grow in coastal waters of Ireland, and they are obtained in a sustainable way. An interesting fact is that alga fibre is produced using brown algae cut every four years so as not to interfere with natural growth processes. Thus, they get the chance to absorb favourable elements of the ocean waters

Alga fibre is a concentrate of minerals floating in the ocean waters, and their estimated lifespan in the fabric is a few dozen washing cycles. Algae in bamboo fabrics can work miracles in direct contact with the skin. They soothe irritation, they have antibacterial properties, and they enrich the skin with minerals. Applied to inflamed areas (diabetic foot), they quicken skin regeneration, which was confirmed by multiple tests on patients suffering from this condition.

We are sure that we offer you the greatest good among fabrics.

Fabrics with marine algae work perfectly as elements of products for babies, personal clothes that come in direct contact with the human skin, and in broadly defined cosmetic and Wellness&SPA industries.





FASHION & HOME

Fabrics from this category are perfect for all kinds of women's fashion products. You can use them in collections of airy dresses and delicate dressing gowns. They are also recommended as fabrics for bed linen and table linen.



NAPPY

These lightweight fabrics, delicate as muslin, are dedicated to babies and children. They are exceptionally pleasant to the touch, absorbent and safe for the skin. Our most demanding Customers frequently select them to produce nappies, wraps, and blankets. Technological capabilities allowed us to introduce new textures of nappy fabrics. We can replace the traditional 'check' with motifs of bears, hearts, and circles children just love. No one else offers it!



SLINC

These are heavy weight fabrics, with a durable, sturdy weave. They will be perfect for a collection of baby wrap carriers, a collection of decorative textiles or to decorate the house.



TOWEL

Do you know what fabric weight is?

This is the weight of fabric per square metre. Thus, the greater the mass of the fabric, the greater its weight. Weight reflects the thickness of threads and weave density. It can be recognised by touch. Fabrics with lower weight include nappies and bed linen. On the other hand, terry towels are made of heavy weight fabrics.



Weight of 170 g/m² is a good idea when you want a fabric with a printed motif. Fabrics of this weight are usually used to produce nappies, wraps, and bed linen.




This is the range of fabrics mostly serving as baby wrap carriers. Fabrics from lower weight ranges (e.g. 220-300g) are used to produce such items as tea towels.



Fabrics with weight of 400-450 g/m² are cotton terry fabrics usually used for towel production. The above weights are also perfect for the production of dressing gowns, hair drying towels, and cosmetic pads.



Thanks to state-of-the-art machines, we are able to produce fabrics with weights adjusted to your needs. Fabrics with weight of 500 g/m² are bamboo terry fabrics. We use them to produce towels and bath robes for babies.





No one else in Poland can offer this!

Our market advantages are innovative technological solutions thanks to which we can create original patterns and unique weaves. What does it mean in practice? While other producers create nappies with a traditional check weave, we can combine fibres in any way, creating patterns such as a school of fish (see the photo to the left).



MONOCOLOUR JACQUARD

Depending on weight, this fabric can be used for different purposes. It is distinguished by a monocolour, so-called embossed pattern.



COLOUR-WOVEN JACQUARD

It can be a delicate nappy or a resistant sling fabric. It is distinguished by a pattern made of multiple coloured threads.



LOOP CONSTRUCTION

Loop construction is mostly used for terry fabrics and products made of it, such as towels. In the case of towels, it is directly responsible for taking care of your skin when you dry it.



CANVAS


Canvas is a cloth with fibres combined in a specific way, with a warp/weft ratio of 1. The canvas weave is one of the basic weaves, serving as a basis for the creation of so-called secondary weaves. Canvas is mostly used as bed linen, tablecloth, tea towel, clothing, and decorative fabric.



MUSLIN

Muslin is a delicate fabric that can be used to produce nappies.

^{*}EXAMPLES OF PRINTED FABRICS





Each fabric originating on a loom undergoes all kinds of 'make-up' processes. This is the finishing process which consists in, for example, removal of loose fibres from the surface and washing. Fabrics are frequently dyed or printed, and these processes grant them their unique character. In TEXPOL, we follow safety measures and environment-friendly procedures at all production stages, including processes that define the final appearance of the fabric and are carried out by our Partners. This is why we work with Partners who have OEKO-TEX®Standard 100 certificates. Thus, when ordering our fabrics you can be sure that you support the environment and take care of our planet!



DYE

You can order a fabric in any Pantone colour and you can be sure that the concentration of the components used is safe for the natural environment. Do you want to learn more? Ask about the minimum dye batch for your order.



PRINT

Nappies with coloured prints are very popular among our Customers. It is possible to print the whole fabric or print a repeating motif. It's all up to you!




OTHER TECHNOLOGICAL PROCESSES
